
Vision, Mission, and Values

- •The academic year is divided into semesters, and students' assessments are given quarterly;
- · English is the medium for instruction for all courses except Chinese studies;
- •The grading system at DWA is numerical, with 60 out of 100 as a passing grade for A-Level&AP programs and 4 for IBDP;
- ·We do not rank students and attendance under 85% receives an 'I' for Incomplete on the transcript;
- •The grades assessed at DWA accurately measure a student's performance among a pool of very high achievers.



Athletic Facilities

DWA boasts top-notch sports venues and facilities, offering various sports activities and professional training. The school is near the Qiantang River to the east, the Jiuqiao Golf Course to the north, and the Hutang River to the south. With ample water space, DWA is perfect for aquatic sports such as kayaking. The school also features ten basketball courts, eight tennis courts, four squash courts, fencing halls, golf practice ranges, equestrian stables, a 50-meter, 8-lane international competition standard swimming pool, and 400-meter outdoor playgrounds. Furthermore, the primary and middle schools have spacious indoor sports halls measuring 1,850 and 3,800 square meters, respectively.
